

Talent Match Leeds City Region

Performance Statistics 2017

Talent Match provides dynamic support for young people across the five areas of the Leeds City Region - helping them get employment and volunteering experience through a range of keyworker and intervention partners based in the community and voluntary sector.

The current programme has been running for 4 years and these statistics are drawn from the operation to October 2017.



- 2242** young people engaged on the programme
- 773** progressed into work
- 423** sustained full time employment for 6 months
- 144** progressed into formal education
- 520** taken part in volunteering



- 65%** have improved their confidence due to taking part
- 51%** have reduced their feelings of anxiety
- 63%** feel more worthwhile as a result of Talent Match
- 67%** **now** feel more satisfied with life as a whole



The success of the programme is due mainly to the dedication, commitment and energy of the Keyworkers in the field.

From January to October 2017 the keyworkers logged **28,611 hours** of mentoring and support to young people in the area.

That's the equivalent of:

1192 days or
3.25 years of continuous support!
